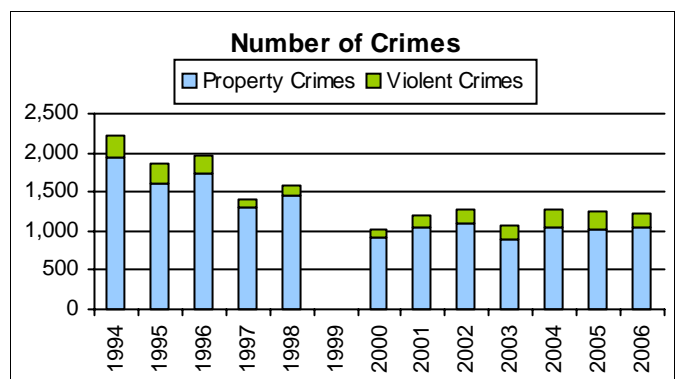

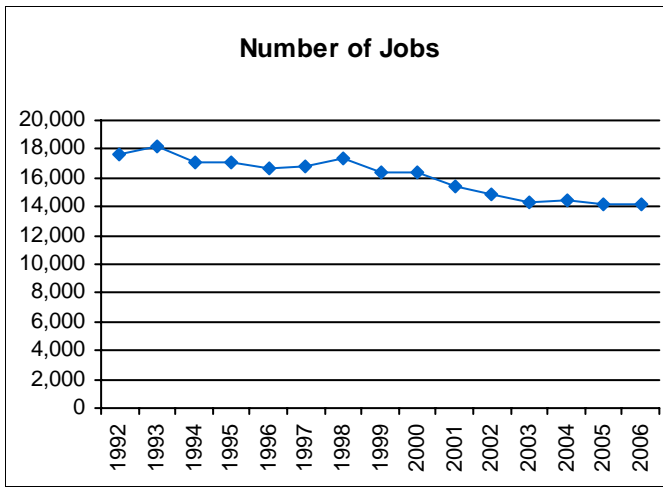

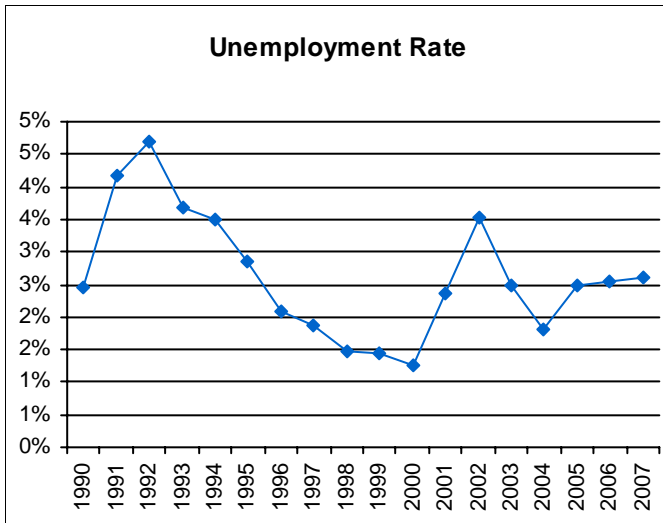

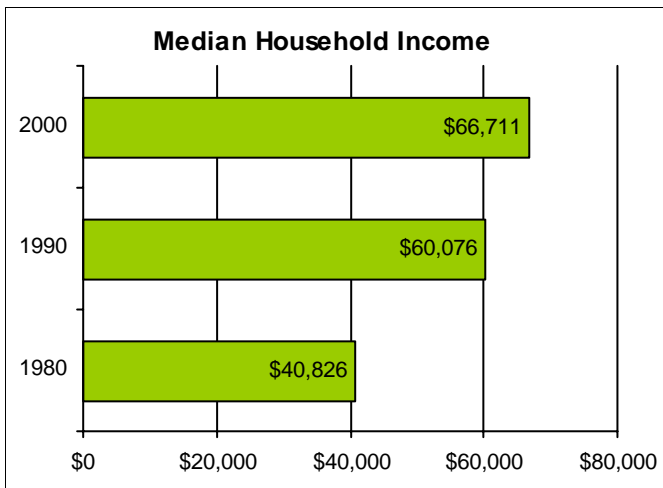

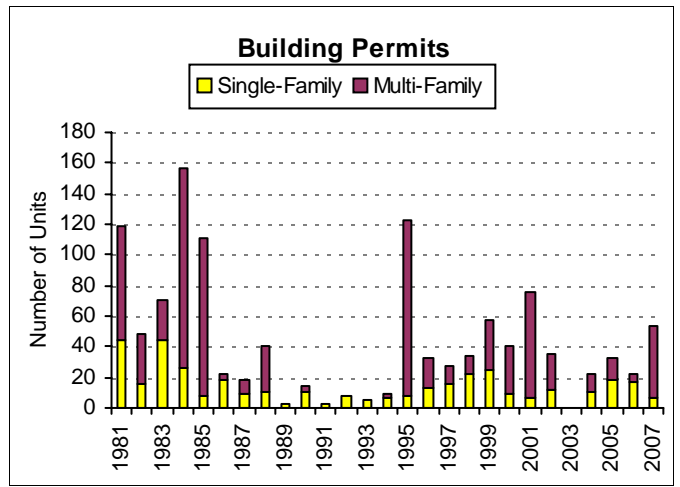

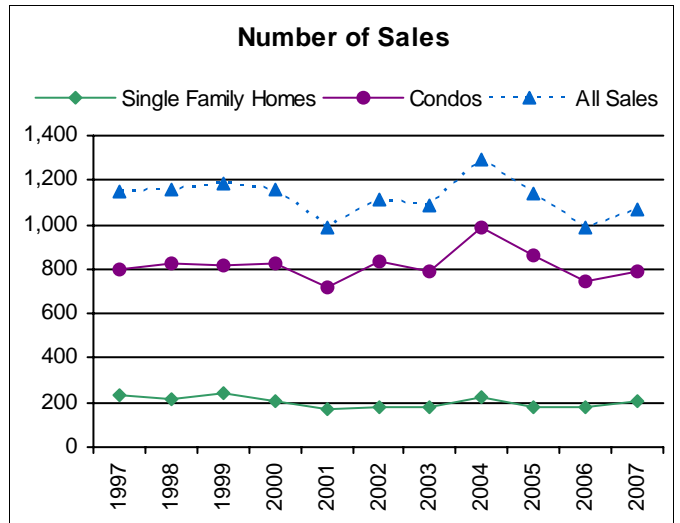

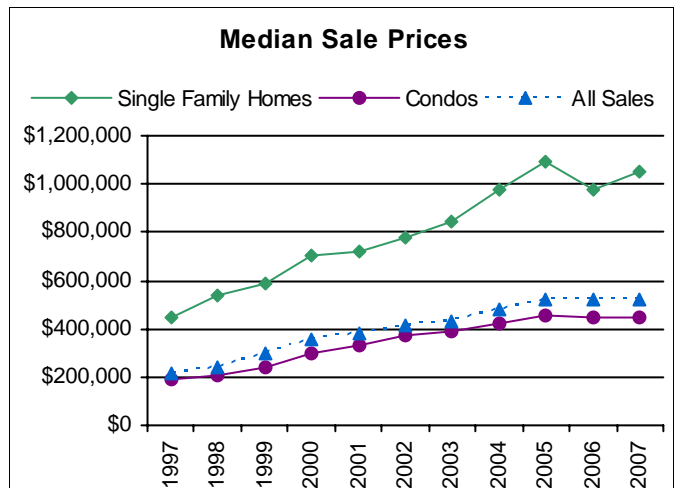

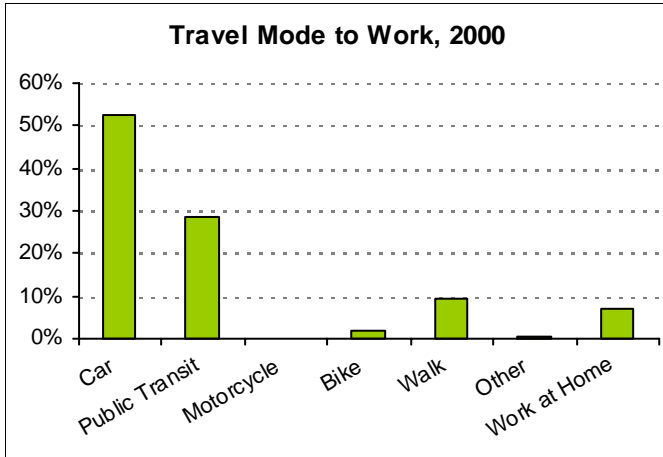

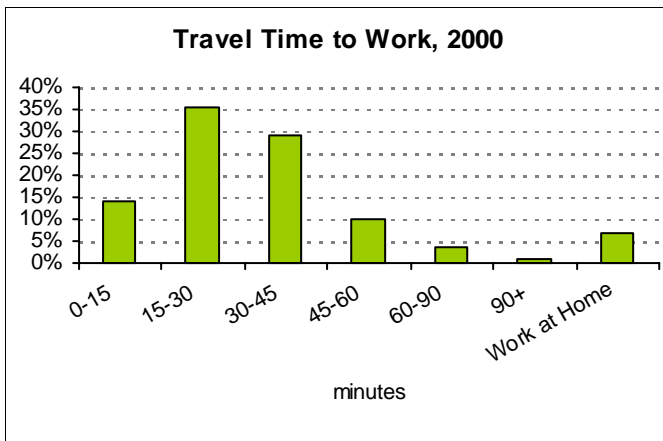

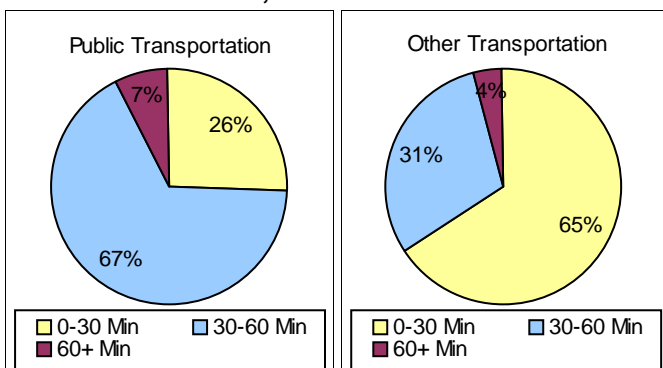

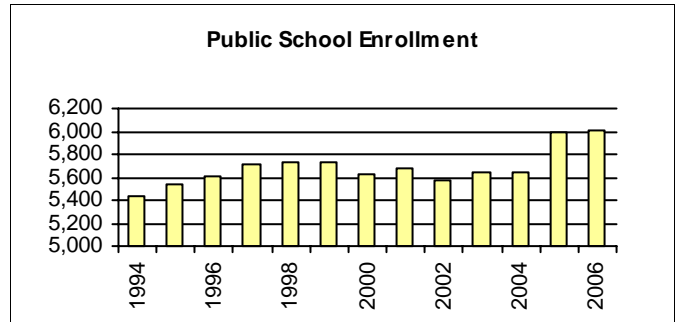

Travel Time to Work, 2000

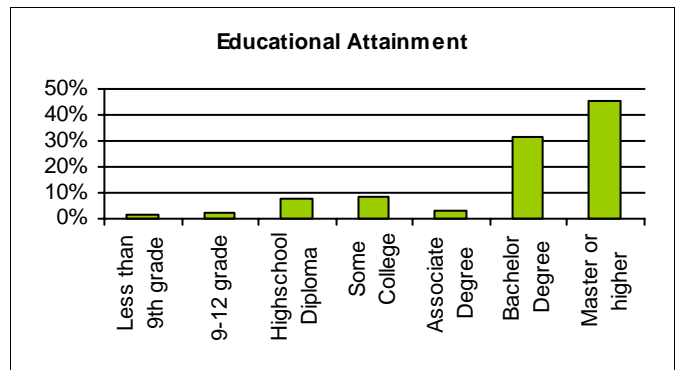

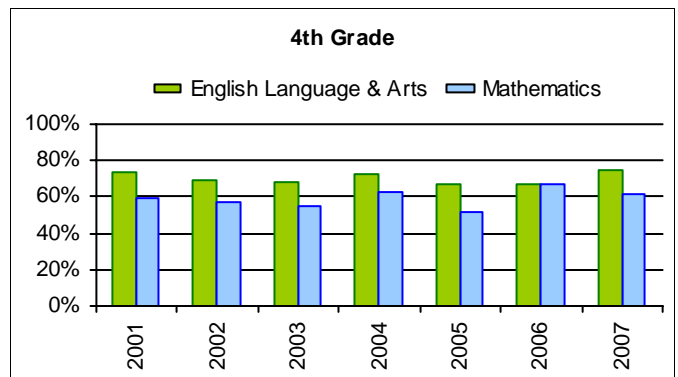

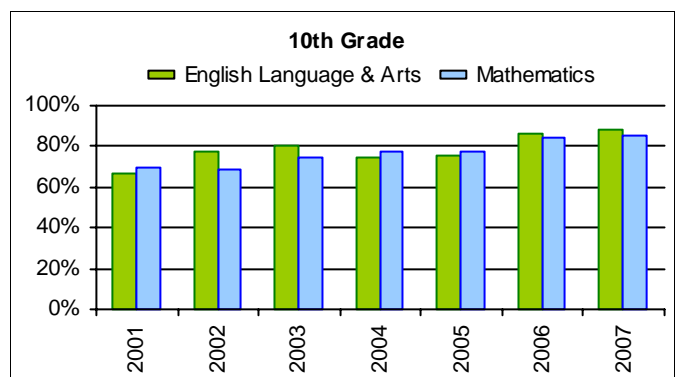

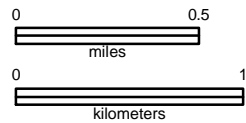
