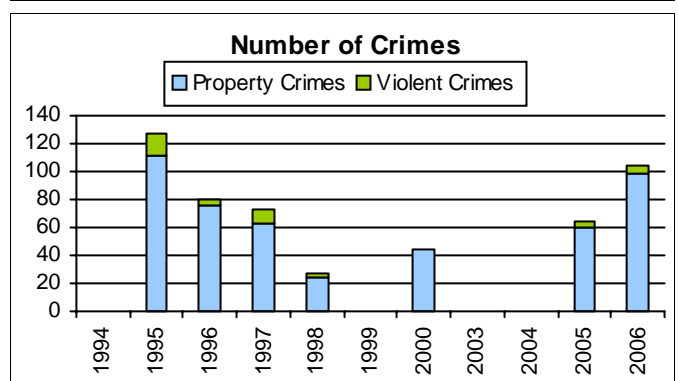

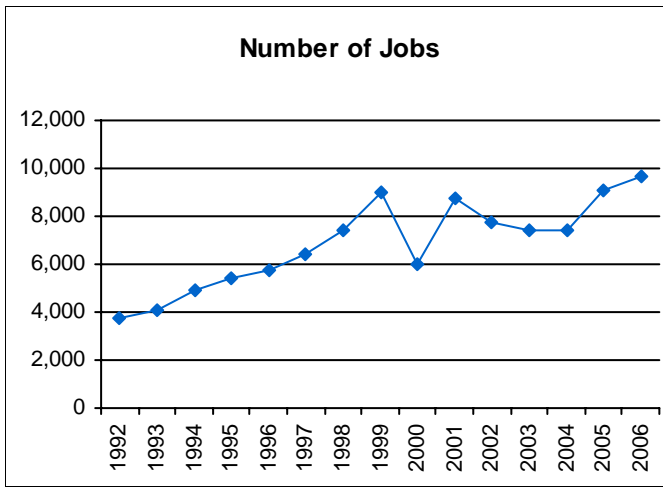

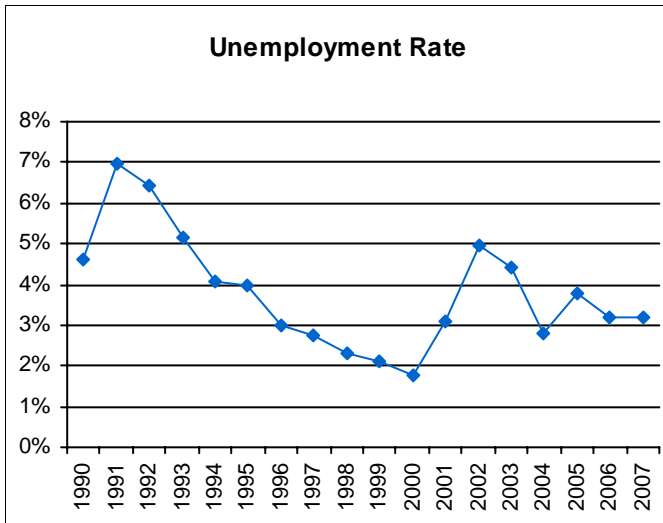

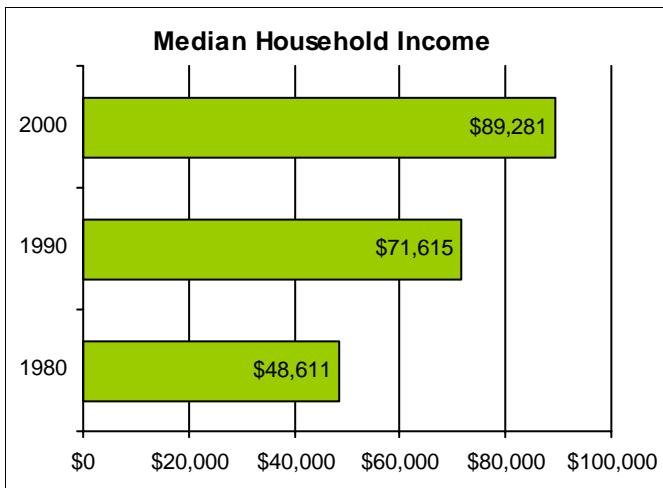

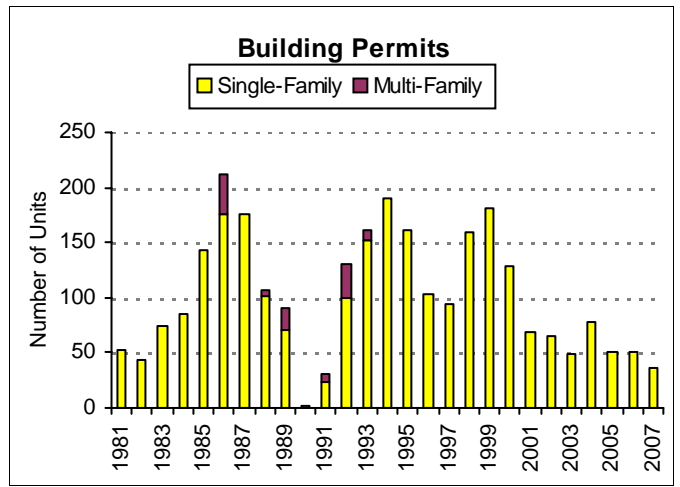

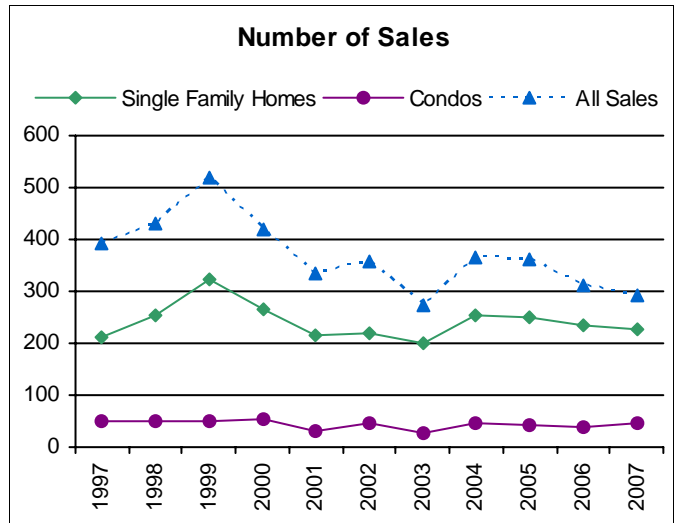

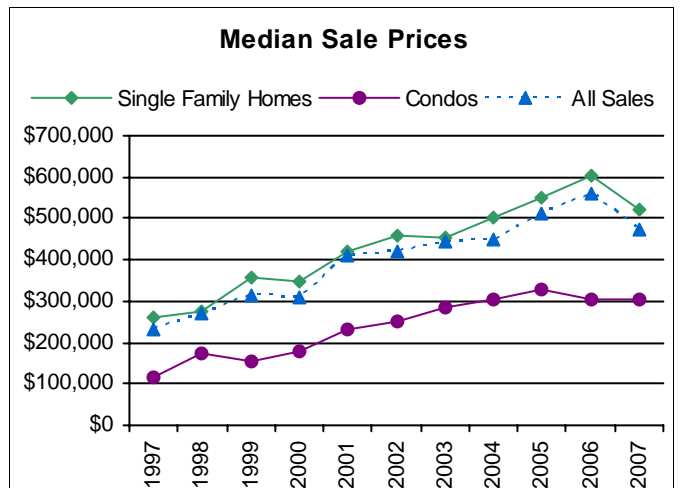

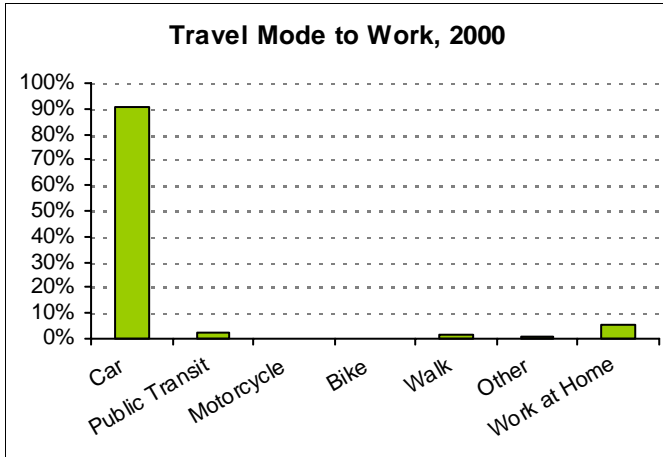

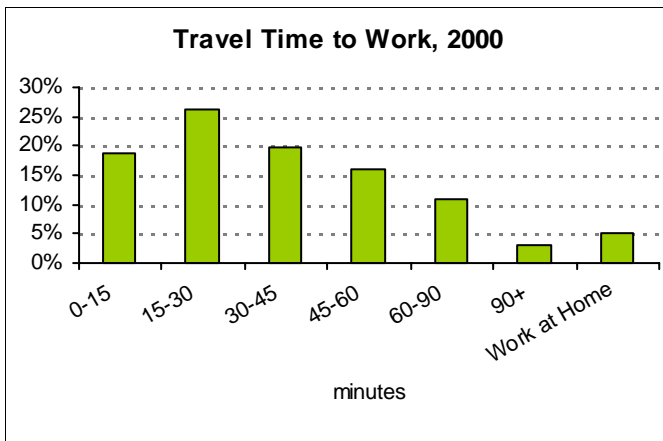

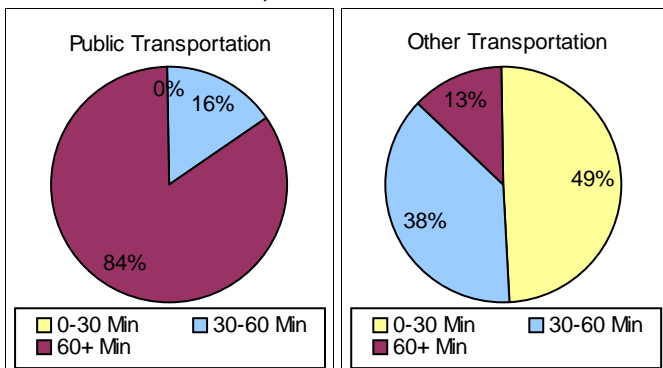

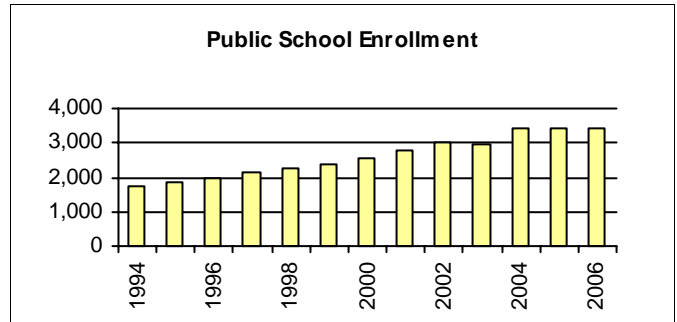

Travel Time to Work, 2000

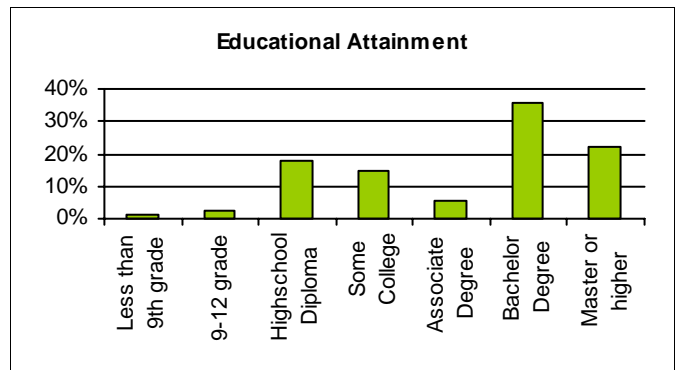

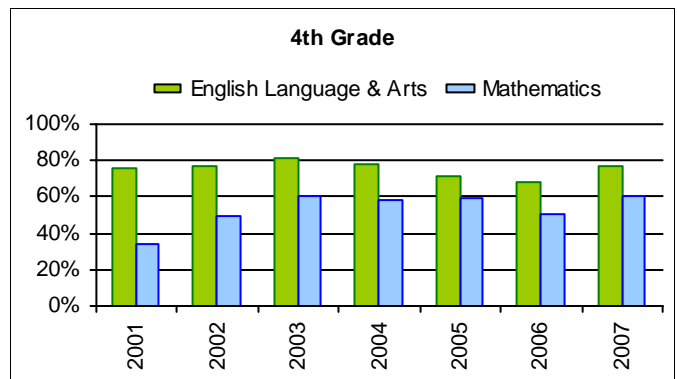

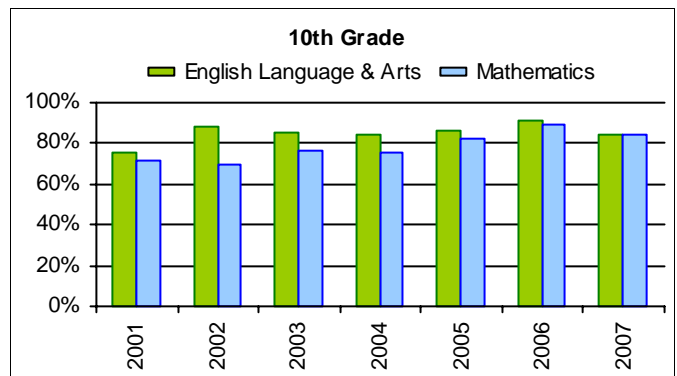

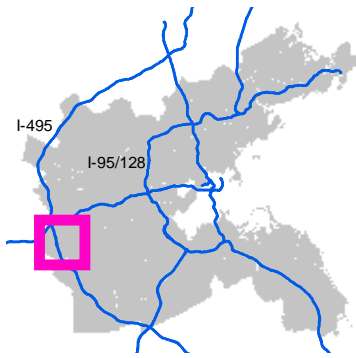

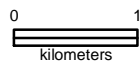
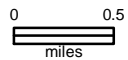
Area of Detail within Metro Boston

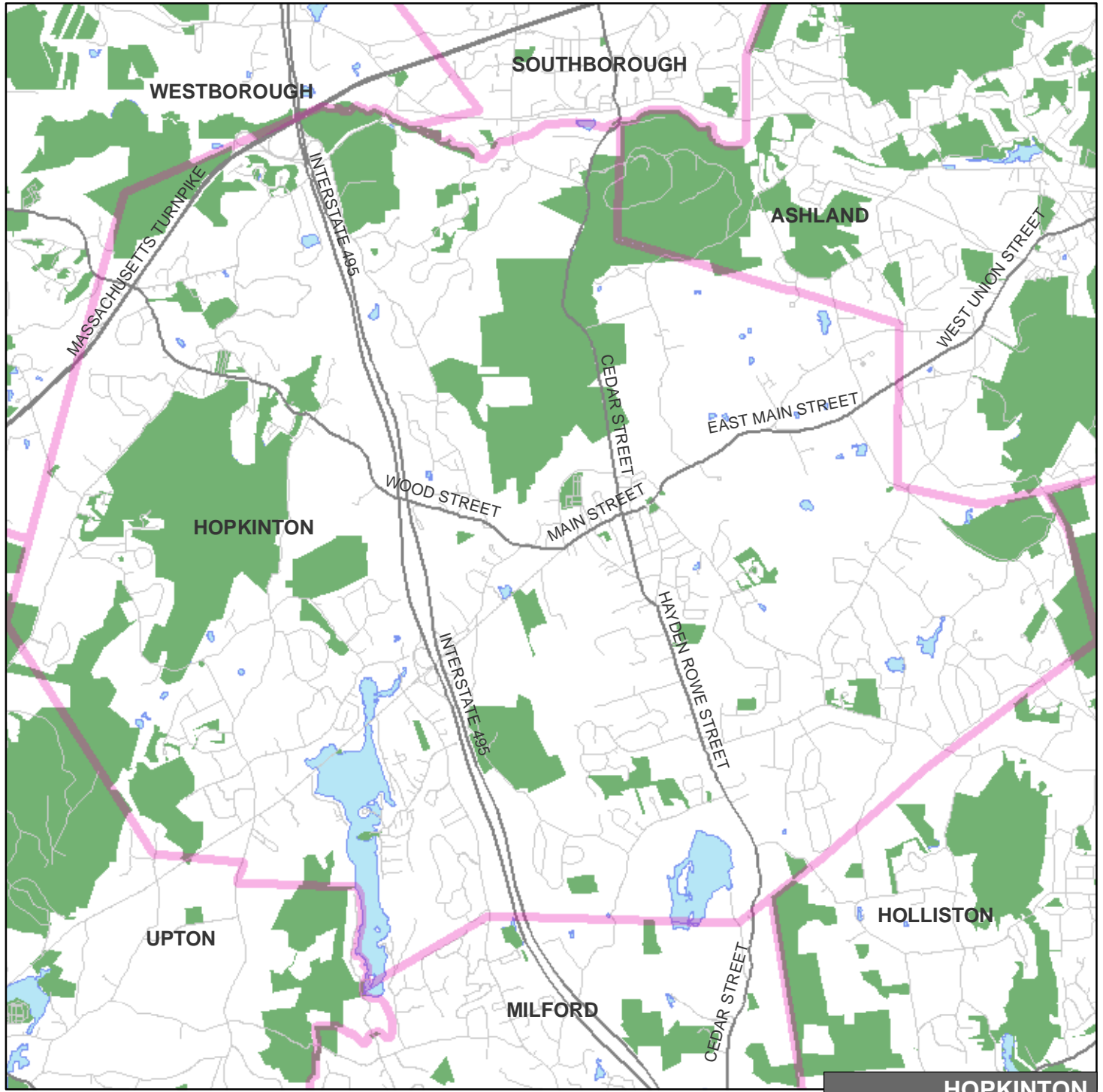
